**** PLAYERS MUST CHECK IN AT REGISTRATION UPON THEIR ARRIVAL ****

**** PLAYERS MUST REPORT TO THEIR STARTING TEE 10 MINUTES BEFORE THEIR STARTING TIME ****

TIME OF STARTING

Rule 5.3a states: “The player must be ready to play at the starting time and starting point set by the Committee.”
Penalty for breach: The player arrives at starting point, ready to play, no more than (5) five minutes late: The player gets the general penalty (2 strokes) applied to his or her first hole. Otherwise, the penalty for breach of this rule is disqualification.

WITHDRAWAL

PRIOR TO EVENT: Notify NJ GOLF by phone (908-241-4653) or email (tournaments@njgolf.org).

DAY OF EVENT: A player must call the pro shop at the club and ask that a message is forwarded to the NJ GOLF Staff.

No-shows will be suspended from competitions for one year.

EQUIPMENT

1. The USGA Groove and Punch Mark Specifications (effective Jan. 1, 2010) are in effect for this competition.

** New Jersey Golf strongly suggests that all players verify the conformance of their clubs well in advance of the competition. It is the player’s responsibility, not NJ Golf’s responsibility to ensure that all clubs conform. Waiting until the day of the competition is the fault of the player. The Committee is under no obligation to test the club, nor will testing mechanism(s) be available at NJ GOLF competitions. The competitor may play. However, if it is later determined that the club is non-conforming, including after the competition has closed, the player will be disqualified.**

2. Only brands of golf balls on the USGA’s latest list of conforming golf balls may be used.

3. Only drivers on the current USGA’s Conforming driver-head list will be permitted.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be dressed appropriately. Those not dressed appropriately will not be permitted to remain on the premises. The following applies: Cargo shorts/pants, denim, t-shirts, undershirts, flip-flops, and sandals are **not** permitted. Appropriate dress includes: A Collared Dress Shirt, Golf or Polo Shirt (tucked in). Hats/visors must be worn forward and removed when inside.

CONDUCT & COURTESY

1. Exemplary conduct is expected of all players, caddies, and spectators. Conduct deemed to be inappropriate may result in disqualification and/or future rejection of entries.

2. The use of cell phones is PROHIBITED on the golf course (except for mobile scoring).

LOCAL RULES

1. The Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and R&A govern play. Local Rules will be provided onsite.

SCORECARDS & SCORING RULES

Official Scorecards will be distributed by the NJ GOLF starter on the starting tee. Upon completing the round, players must report directly to the scoring table where scores shall be checked for each hole and doubtful points settled with the committee. Both the Player and Marker MUST sign the scorecard. The starter will give each group their GGID to allow them to enter hole-by-hole scores for "live scoring" and check the leaderboard through the Golf Genius app.

CLUBHOUSE/LOCKER/PRACTICE FACILITIES

All facilities (clubhouse, locker room, driving range, putting green) will open at 6:30 a.m.

PACE OF PLAY

The NJ GOLF Pace of play system will be in effect; [see separate notice](#). Timing guidelines (per hole) will be indicated on each player's official scorecard. Pace of play will be monitored and penalized if necessary.

FORMAT & SCHEDULE

Day 1: 18-Holes, Stroke-Play Qualifying. The low 16 scorers advance to match play on day 2 and 3. If there is a tie for final qualifying place(s), a hole-by-hole playoff will be held upon the conclusion of stroke play.

Day 2: Match Play; Round of 16 Morning; quarterfinals to follow. Morning play begins at 7:30 a.m.

Day 3: Semifinals in morning; final match to follow. A player who wins his morning match should be prepared to play his afternoon match **35-45 minutes** after the match concludes. The champion will be awarded the Gigi Carnevale Championship Trophy; prizes are awarded to the champion, runner-up, and semifinalists.

TRANSPORTATION / CADDIES

Motorized transportation is PROHIBITED in this competition. A player must walk; he may carry his bag, bring his own caddie (subject to dress code), or reserve a caddie. The club caddie rate, per player, is \$120 per bag (plus tip). Caddies are limited and must be reserved in advance by contacting Tom McCormack by email TomM@alpinecc.org. **Pull carts are NOT PERMITTED.**

FOOD & BEVERAGE

On day 1, continental breakfast and lunch are included in each player's entry fee and will be available from 11:00a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Players will receive a lunch ticket upon completing their round or at the registration table. Lunch (for non-players) may be purchased for \$20.00. Players will be on their own to purchase lunch on day 2 and 3. Drinking water will be available on the golf course.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

New Jersey Golf will exhaust every effort to conduct the competition on its scheduled date. Play would only be disrupted in the case of lightning or unplayable course conditions. Anyone in doubt as to whether play might be delayed, suspended, or cancelled should check the NJ GOLF web site: www.njgolf.org for information.

PRACTICE ROUND

The club has graciously offered each player one (1) practice round. There is a mandatory \$50 fee (includes cart) which is payable by **CASH** or Reciprocal Club Charge. Players must call the golf shop in advance to arrange a practice round. Players will be grouped with other competitors. Practice round dates are as follows:
